SUBJECT: TRIP NUMBERING SYSTEM

All Trip numbers are 5 digits. Block numbers are coded so that the first two digits are the line number. The third digit is the day of service. The 4th & 5th digits is the number of that particular trip. The first trip is always 1.

This system applies to all lines, whether they are operated from a single division or multiple divisions.

Breakdown of Trip Number Components

The first two digits - Line number (Example (01, 43, 114)

The third digit - Service Day

Weekday Eastbound or Northbound - 0 Weekday Westbound or Southbound - 1 Saturday Eastbound or Northbound - 5 Saturday Westbound or Southbound - 6 Sunday Eastbound or Northbound - 7 Sunday Westbound or Southbound - 8

The fourth & fifth digits - The trip number in sequential order

Examples: 03106 Route 3, Weekday, Westbound, 6th trip

15001 Route 15, Weekday, Northbound, 1st trip

11402 Route 114, 2nd trip (Note that the Service Day is not

used as 111-118 only operate on Weekdays.)

41509 Route 41, Saturday, Eastbound, 9th trip 55705 Route 55, Sunday, Northbound, 5th trip
